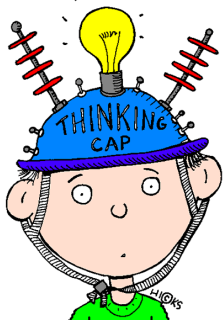

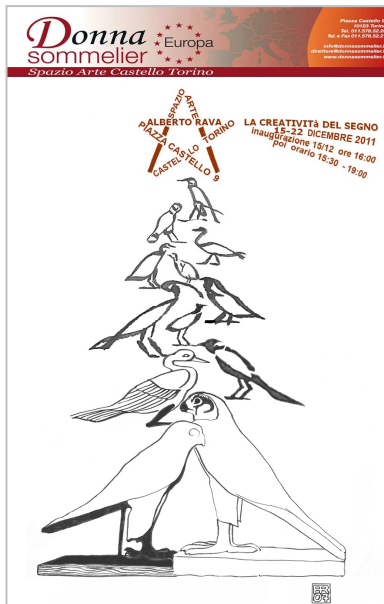
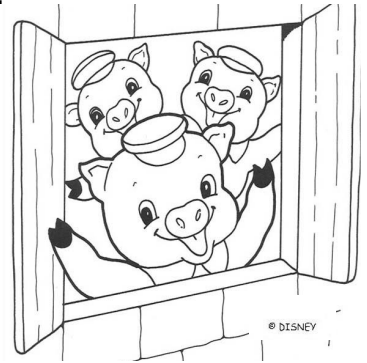


## Thinking caps on, please!

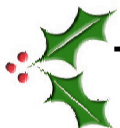


## Showing the Christmas Spirit
